



Site Preparation:


Before proceeding amend your subfloor as needed. Ensure it is level, free of damage and provides adequate support. The floor under the bath must be capable of supporting 50lb./ft² or 240 kg M².

Step 1







The alcove framing must be plumb and square. The floor must be level.

Step 2





The bathtub must be level in both directions. The bathtub apron and all legs must be in firm contact with the floor. Test for proper drainage before proceeding.

Step 3




If the gap between the bottom of the tub and the floor is too large, add four generous mounds of thin-set to support the tub.

Step 4




Pre-drill the tiling flange and fasten in place with coated screws. No weight should be carried by the tiling flange.

Step 5






Single Tiling Flange

Apply 100% silicone sealant around the bath along the finished walls and deck.

ROUTINE CARE & CLEANING

Your bathtub is made from cast acrylic and will maintain its superior finish and beauty for many years with minimal care.

The instructions below are designed to assist you in keeping your tub looking “new”.

Follow these simple steps:

For normal care and cleaning use a soft cloth or sponge with soap and water. Rinse well and dry with soft clean cloth.

Never use abrasive cleaners.

Clean grease, oil, paint and ink stains with a dab of isopropyl (rubbing) alcohol. Rinse well with water and dry with a soft clean cloth.

Do not allow your acrylic surface to come into contact with nail polish, nail polish remover, Wintergreen oil, dry cleaning solution, lacquer thinners, gasoline, pine oil, all essential oils, etc.

Avoid placing razor blades or other sharp instruments on the bathtub surface as they may scratch it.

To remove joint / drywall compound, use a plastic or wood spatula covered with a damp cloth.

If a rubber bathmat is used during showering/ bathing, it must be removed immediately after each use. Leaving the bathmat in the bathtub after use will damage the acrylic surface.

Periodic cleaning using a specially formulated acrylic cleanser such as Gel-Gloss is recommended to thoroughly clean the surface and apply a protective coating. This will help maintain the high luster of the acrylic finish.

SCRATCHED / DAMAGED SURFACES

Small scratches can be removed by buffing lightly with a clean cloth and using either an automotive polishing liquid or toothpaste containing a fine polishing ingredient.

For deeper scratches, sand the surface lightly with 600 grit “wet or dry” paper and a generous amount of water. Once the scratch has been sanded away, progress through 800 and then 1200 grit “wet or dry” sand paper while continually refreshing the water.

Finish all repairs by buffing the area back to a glossy finish by using a clean cloth and automotive polishing compound.
